Interior - All Rooms

- Open curtains and blinds
- Turn off fans and clean the blades
- Keep pets out of sight
- Hide trash cans
- Declutter and depersonalize

 garages and closets these make great

Exterior


- Park away from the house
- Cut grass, mulch and weed flower beds
- Hide trash and recycle bins
- Put away toys, hoses, and other movable outdoor items
- Rake leaves and sweep decks and sidewalks



Kitchen + Dining Areas

- Clear counters of small appliances,cutting boards, and food
- Remove magnets from refrigerator
- Hide trash cans, pet and baby items
- Keep the sink and top of the refrigerator and cabinets empty
- Set out place settings or a centerpiece on the table for staging





Living + Entrance Areas

- Hide cords, remotes, and magazines
- Remove personal items and anything with your name
- ☐ Turn off the TV
- Put away toys, baby and pet items
- Remove excess decor keep it simple and neutral
- Hide shoes, coats, purses, etc.
- Remove seasonal, personalized, or dirty doormats

Bedrooms

- Put away clothing and shoes
- Hide laundry baskets
- Remove personal items
- Put away stand up and portable fans
- Make the bed
- Remove clutter from nightstandsHide phone cords

Bathrooms

- Clear off vanity tops
- Remove bath mats and towels
- Remove items inside the shower
- Hide laundry baskets, scales, toilet
 brushes, plungers, and trash cans
